Fully stripped in 1976 and equipped with the characteristic hunting structure. In 2015, the building was professionally re-engineered in 2015 and in 2017 the engine was completely overhauled. The sailing characteristics of the ship are fantastic. The cockpit is finished with teak wood manufactured by Jachtwerf Piersma in Heeg. The three front hatches are made of the same teak. In 2015 the ship underwent a refit. The interior has been completely refurbished by a professional ship carpenter. Beautiful solid Iroko floor parts throughout the cabin. The ship exudes coziness and class. The ship is definitely worth a visit.
